CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay is a green-skinned grape variety used to make white wine. It is believed to have originated in the burgundy wine region of eastern France. There are two distinctive styles of Chardonnay, the rich buttery meursault and the new world wines which have more tropical fruit flavor. Chardonnay will pair well with poultry dishes, pork, seafood or recipes that have a heavy cream or butter base.

Riesling is often a confusing grape variety. It can be made sweet, though generally it will be very dry and clean finishing. It is the king of German wines and was originally planted there. The most popular flavors in Riesling are green apple and citrus. Riesling also has a great home in Alsace in France on the German border which produces amazing wines excellent with salads and lighter meat dishes.

RED WINE

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Cabernet sauvignon often referred to as the "king of red wine grapes," originally from Bordeaux. Cabernet sauvignon grapes tend to favor warmer climates and are often an ideal wine for aging, with 5-10 years being optimal for the maturation process to peak because Cabernets take a bit longer to reach maturation. This allows their flavors to mellow, creating a softer finish. Cabernet Sauvignon goes well with red meats, flavorful and heartier pastas, lamb, strong flavored cheese and dark chocolates.

MERLOT

Merlot is a red wine grape that is used as both a blending grape and for varietal wines. Merlot-based wines usually have medium body with hints of berry, plum, and black currant. It's softness and fleshiness, combined with its earlier ripening, makes merlot a popular grape for blending with the sterner later-ripening cabernet sauvignon, which tends to be higher in tannin.

SHIRAZ

Shiraz or Syrah is known for its spicy blackberry, plum and peppery flavors. Often there are additional notes of licorice, bitter chocolate and mocha. Shiraz is affected by the growing temperature- warmer climates bring out the mellower flavors of plum, while cooler temperatures spice up the wine. Shiraz can be made in a fruity style, which many "sweet" wine drinkers enjoy. It can also be made in a dry style. Wines made from shiraz grapes are often powerfully flavored and full bodied.
